3 24-05-2017 The onus is on the petitioner to cooperate with the authorities and provide details of the deductions for the period 1981 to 10.8.1997 since the petitioner was a Class I Officer, therefore, he also has certain responsibility in helping the respondents to settle his claim for payment of GPF amount. No sooner the petitioner provides the details, the authorities will ensure that the GPF is authorized and paid. The GPF authorities should also try to obtain the details at their level as well.

Petitioner is free to approach the authorities for any



other left over legitimate claim, who will verify the authenticity of the same and if needed, also address the issue within a limited time frame.
