4 06-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioners are languishing in custody for
offences punishable under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

According to F.I.R. Pappu Ram, the co-villager
of the informant, disclosed to the informant that the petitioners had
fired causing death of the two sons of the informant. He further
disclosed that other 8 to 10 persons were also firing.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing
on behalf of the State, after going through the case-diary, submits
that one of the injured in the occurrence Krishnandan Singh does



not claim to have identified the petitioners in his statement before the police.

Considering the fact that there is no cogent evidence against the petitioners, let petitioners, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar, in connection with Sheohar P.S. Case No. 129 of 2013.
