The learned Writ Court having exercised its discretion in interfering with the imposition of penalty under Section 14-B and interest under Section 7-Q of the Employees Provident Fund Miscellaneous Provision Act, 1952 finding the employer petitioners-respondents herein to have deposited the amount immediately on receipt of the notice and further the act of the Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner in waiving the non-



deposit of employees’ contribution, we see no reason to make any indulgence into the matter. The appeal is dismissed.

The amount recovered and collected from the respondents herein be paid back to them within a period of one month.
