ORAL ORDER

The petitioner seeks bail in Chewara P.S. Case No. 18 of 2015, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A, 304B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The informant went to the house of his daughter and he found his daughter dead. The informant alleged that the petitioner and other family members were torturing his daughter due to non-fulfillment of additional demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the husband of the deceased. The trial is in progress and examined witnesses have not supported the case of the prosecution.



Considering the facts aforesaid and the facts that there is allegation that the petitioner killed his wife and the trial is in progress, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner above named on bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

The trial court is directed to expedite the trial holding on day-to-day basis and conclude the same within six months from the date of receipt of this order.
