3 10-01-2017 This is an application for grant of bail for offences
punishable under Sections 364/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
he is not named in the F.I.R. but, as a matter of fact, he has been
made accused on the basis of further statement of the informant.
Another accused person has already been acquitted in this case.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both the parties and in view of the fact
that petitioner is an absconder in this case for four years and he
has been arrested and remanded in jail custody on 17.5.2016, I am
not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, same is rejected.

However, the court below, i.e., learned Additional



Sessions Judge, Ist , Begusarai, is directed to expedite the trial in connection with Sessions Trial no. 436 of 2016 arising out of Nayagaon P. S. Case no. 34 of 2002 and conclude the same within a period of six months, if not petitioner is at liberty to move for bail before the trial court.
