Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The salary of the petitioner has been attached as per directions of the Station House Officer, Daniawan to the Branch Manager, State Bank of india, Gulzarbagh following institution of a police case arising from Alamganj P.S. Case No. 164 of 2015 registered for offence punishable under Sections 406 and 409 of the Indian Penal Code and another arising from Daniawan P.S.
