Apart from the fact that the delay of about three years in filing of the L.P.A. is not properly explained, the petitioner has approached this Court after inordinate delay. They claim for grant of A.C.P. after completing twelve years of service in the year 1992 and the writ petition was filed 12 years after retirement in the year 2009.



Taking note of the facts and circumstances, the petitioner having slept over the matter not only during his service period but also three years after disposal of the writ petition, we see no reason to make indulgence into the matter.

The appeal stands dismissed.
