ORAL ORDER

4 16-08-2017 Contempt application is heard and dismissed. No case for contempt is made out. The petitioner cannot be allowed to carry out a proxy war against the managing committee, which has decided not to recommend him for the post of Principal. Since they are affiliated college, they have power to recommend anyone for the post of Principal. It is the turn of the petitioner now may be to approach a civil court of competent jurisdiction to seek a declaration against a person, namely, Sri Ramesh Prasad Verma as the In-charge Principal of the College.

Contempt stands disposed of.
