The present restoration petition has been filed for restoring another restoration petition i.e. M.J.C.No. 1528 of 2017, which stood dismissed on 28.06.2017 due to non-prosecution.

Learned counsel for the petitioners tried to persuade the Court about the reason for non-appearance.
