Heard parties.

The petitioner and respondent nos. 7, 8 & 9 are present in person. The girl has alleged before us that she has been tortured by the in-laws and marriage was result of deception and also husband is having illicit relationship with another woman.

However, it has been stated on behalf of the writ



petitioner that after issuance of notice in this case, a Complaint Case No.501 of 2017 making false allegation against the petitioner has been filed.

Be that as it may, we are not in a position to express our opinion on this issue but in a nutshell the girl is not ready to live with her husband. In such a situation, since the girl has already been produced before us, no further order can be passed in this writ application in favour of the writ petitioner.

Accordingly, this writ application stands disposed of.

However, this order would not come in the way of the parties in seeking any remedial recourse which would be permissible to them in law.
