ORAL ORDER

3 07-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 15 of 2016 registered under Sections 498 (A) of the I.P.C. and 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act pending in the Court of S.D.J.M., Munger.

In view of the report of Mediation & Conciliation Center, the dispute between the parties could not be resolved. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and in-laws.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State



vehemently opposed the prayer of the petitioner with submission that petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and on perusal of several paragraphs of the case diary, several witnesses have supported the allegation of demand, torture and assault against the petitioner and others.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of the allegation, I am not inclined to allow the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, prayer of the petitioner is rejected.
