Procured kind of medical certificates only to fill in the gaps cannot form the basis for condonation of delay of 15 years. The Tribunal, therefore, has dismissed OA 166/2016 as well as MA 81/2016 on 28.07.2016 refusing to condone any kind of delay and allow relief to the petitioner.

The Tribunal was absolutely correct in not entertaining the OA or the MA on made up kind of prescriptions obtained to fill in



the blanks between 20th of September, 2000 to 21.03.2015.

Writ is dismissed. The impugned order does not suffer from any vice.
