4 15-03-2017 The instant application is filed for restoration of

C.W.J.C. No. 593 of 2011, which was dismissed for non-

compliance of peremptory order, dated 30.06.2011.

It appears that on 30.06.2011, the petitioner was

directed to file requisites both under ordinary process as well as

registered cover with A/D.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as he

could not hear the order clearly, he filed requisites only under
