2 06-04-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 13.12.2016 in connection with Hasanpur P.S. Case No. 121 of 2016 for the offences alleged under Sections 447, 341, 323, 307, 379, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated as there is case and counter case between the parties. The alleged occurrence resulted from a petty dispute and both sides including the petitioner have suffered injury. The assault attributed to the petitioner has resulted in fracture on the arm of the informant which, however, is on non-vital part of the body. The petitioner claims clean antecedents.

4. Having regard to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rosera, Samastipur in connection with Hasanpur P.S. Case No. 121 of 2016 with the following conditions:-



(i) That one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner.

(ii) That the petitioner shall not indulge in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

(iii) That the petitioner shall remain physically present in court on each and every date during trial and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.

(iv) The petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation, if not already concluded, and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the State shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.
