2 11-04-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

This is a petition for grant of regular bail for offences under Sections 30(A) and 38 of the Bihar Excise Act.

From the referred four wheeler, 440 liters of liquor was recovered. The petitioners were apprehended at the spot.

Submission of the petitioners is that the liquor does not belong to them and they were merely passengers. They are in custody since 29.12.2016.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-



(rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with **Nabinagar P.S. Case No. 229 of 2016** to the satisfaction of the **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad**, or successor Court on completion of four months in custody.
