learned A.P.P. for the State.

The Petitioner seeks bail in Sahebpur Kamal P.S.

Case No. 171 of 2016 instituted for the offence under Sections

302, 201 and 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that

the petitioner is father-in-law of the deceased and mere suspicion

has been raised against him. In the written report it has been

alleged that the dead body of a female and three minor children

were recovered near Sanha Halt. The dead bodies were thrown at

some distance of the aforesaid Halt by cutting their necks. The

F.I.R. has been lodged against unknown on 19.9.2016 by the

Choukidar. Thereafter one petition has been filed by the brother



of the deceased on 25.09.2016 (Annexure-2) raising suspicion against this petitioner, who is father-in-law, and also levelled specific allegation against the husband of the deceased.

The case diary has been received.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that the witnesses have raised mere suspicion against this petitioner.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the Petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-V, Begusarai in connection with Sahebpur Kamal P.S. Case No. 171 of 2016, subject to the conditions that both the bailors shall be the close relative of the petitioner.
