6 10-04-2017 In the light of the order, dated 07.04.2017, a supplementary affidavit has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, which has been sworn by his elder brother Binod Choudhary. The petitioner is a juvenile and is an accused of offence punishable under Section 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code. He was allowed bail by an order of this Court, dated 27.03.2017, with the condition that father of the petitioner shall furnish personal bond, unmindful of the fact that the petitioner's father had already died.
