5. 12-07-2017 Sri Ratnakar Jha, learned counsel for the petitioner, in presence of learned A.C. to Principal Addl. Advocate General – 2, submits that due to inadvertence, some error has occurred in the petition and instead of making prayer for restoration of “M.J.C. No. 4083 of 2014”, it has incorrectly been typed as “C.W.J.C. No. 285 of 2014”. Accordingly, he makes a prayer for making correction to this effect in the present petition.
