Petitioner is ready for reconciliation and is in custody since 28.12.2016.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on **provisional bail** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief
