3 07-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is apprehending his arrest
in connection with Chapra Muffasil P.S. Case No. 49 of 2016
registered for offences under sections 420 of the Indian Penal
Code.

In the present case, the petitioner is claiming that he
is the brother of the owner of the showroom. The complainant has
taken Rota Bettor and asked to pay money after sometime. Later
on, he gave a cheque which was submitted in the bank for
clearance but, the same got dishonored and, for that, the petitioner
has filed a criminal case against the Informant. As a counter blast,
the present case has been filed for cheating.



Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, namely, Yogendra Chaurasiya @ Yogendra Prasad, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Chapra Mufassil P.S. Case No. 49 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
