2 18-05-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with Sessions
Trial No. 322 of 2016 arising out of Mahnar P.S. Case No. 64 of
2014 registered under Section 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing of the daughter of the
informant and disposed of her dead body by her husband and in-
laws due to non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

Submission is that the petitioner is father-in-law of the
deceased. There is general and omnibus allegation of demand of
dowry and killing of the deceased. The petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and he is in custody since 26.10.2016.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of



the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Sessions Trial No. 322 of 2016 arising out of Mahnar P.S. Case No. 64 of 2014, subject to the condition that out of two sureties, one surety must be the close relative of the petitioner.
