Counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of
disproportionate punishment as the only allegation against him was
not achieving the target with regard to 'Jalkar' for which a major
punishment has been awarded to him.

Counsel for the State raises a preliminary objection that
the order is appealable before the Government which is not disputed
by the petitioner.



The petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedy of appeal before the Government. The same may be decided expeditiously, without being prejudiced by dismissal of the case.
