

Time Bound Promotion was sanctioned in favour of the petitioner and it was forwarded by the Superintendent Engineer(Mechanical) Irrigation Circle, Muzaffarpur vide letter no.428 dated 09.04.2011. Thereafter, it was indicated that as soon as the second time bound promotion sanctioned to the petitioner is confirmed by the Water Resources Department, the proposal for revision of pension of the petitioner will be submitted to the Accountant General, Bihar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing of the counter affidavit, despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get any further instruction as to whether in view of statements made in the counter affidavit, consequential benefit has been granted to the petitioner or not. He submits that in such situation, the writ petition may be disposed of with observation that if any grievance still exists, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy.

Accordingly, there is no need to keep the matter pending. The writ petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner that if any grievance of the petitioner relating to the relief sought for in the present writ petition



still exists, he would be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy.

With above observation, the writ petition stands disposed of.
