Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, State and the
respondent no. 7.

The challenge in the present writ petition is to the order
dated 15.04.2013 passed in Case No. 115 of 2012 by the D.C.L.R,
Pakri Dayal in the District of East Champaran.

At the very outset learned counsel for the respondent no.
8 raised a preliminary objection and submitted that the order
impugned is appealable under Section 14 of the Bihar Land Disputes
Resolution Act, 2009 before the Divisional Commissioner.
