This writ application will be treated to have
become infructuous for two reasons, one, that the necessary
amendment in Rule 8(1) of the Indian Forest Service
(Probation) Rules, 1968 has been amended, and secondly,
because of the interim order of the court, the petitioner
participated in the civil services examination and has been
successful with exemplary rank in service.

In view of the same, the writ application is



allowed. The impediment which was sought to be created by the Union of India by the Rule, as it existed then, is of no avail now in the changed circumstances.

The impugned order dated 23.07.2015 (Annexure-5 to the writ application) stands quashed.

The writ application is disposed off.
