2 20-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
19.05.2017 in a case for the offence registered under Sections
304(B) and 201/34 of the IPC.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the petitioner
and others killed the daughter of the informant due to non-
fulfillment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.
Charge sheet has been submitted in the present case. He has got
no concern with the alleged occurrence. He is a resident of
different village. The husband of the deceased is in custody.



On behalf of the learned counsel for the State, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M. Muzaffarpur in connection with Saraiya P.S. Case No. 195/2017.
