Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for
offences under Sections 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 330 litres
Nepali Wine were recovered from the possession of both the
petitioners. Petitioners claim that they are having clean
antecedent and are in custody since 21.05.2017.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of



the case, the petitioners, above named are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with C-2 308/17/193/2017 with a condition that if the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found to be involved in criminal case of similar nature, the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
