counsel appearing on behalf of the informant.

The petitioner is an accused in Sheikhpura (Sirari
O.P.) P.S. Case No. 250 of 2015 for the offence under sections
323/307 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

From perusal of Annexure-2, it appears that police
after investigation submitted final form, saying that accusation
was untrue.

Counsel for the informant submits that after
submission of the final form, the Magistrate differed and took

P.S. Case No. 250 of 2015 on the condition that the petitioner will extend full cooperation in the trial and will not, in any manner, tamper with the evidence or influence the witnesses.
