ORAL ORDER

2 19-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehends their arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 31 of 2017 registered under Sections 323, 504, 506, 420 of the Indian Penal Code and section 67 of the I.T. Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioners have never misused the alleged photograph of the informant with one Md. Shaukat, who has affair with informant. Further submission is that during the course of investigation, witnesses even father, mother and brother of the informant have made allegation only against Md. Shaukat.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Darbhanga in connection with Darbhanga Mahila P.S. Case No. 31 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
