State.

Petitioners, already in custody, seek bail in Mehsi
PS Case No. 220 of 2016 registered under Sections 323,
324, 307, 448, 379, 504, 506/34 of the IPC

The allegation is that the accused persons assaulted
the informant and the specific allegation against the
petitioners is that they gave sword blow over the
informant and his father.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners and the informant side are agnates. There is
case and counter case due to land dispute and so called
injuries alleged to be caused by the petitioners are



simple in nature. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the said facts and circumstances, the petitioners, namely, Bablu Rai and Ramnath Rai are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) by each one of them with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 6th ACJM East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Mehshi PS Case No. 220 of 2016.
