Petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in
Sessions Trial Nb. 174 of 2016 arising out of Sikandra PS
Case Nb. 181 of 2015 registered under Section 302/34 of
the IPC

The allegation in brief is that the accused persons
killed father-in-law of the informant by drowning him in
the water and when she raised alarm they fled away.

The submission on behalf of the petitioner is that
the allegation is false and fabricated. The informant's
father-in-law died due to injury caused by hard blunt
substance and not by drowning as alleged and the same is
reflected from the postmortem report. Other co-accused



similarly situated have been considered bail by the coordinate Bench of this Court.

Having considered the said facts and circumstances, the petitioner, namely, Chandan Mistry is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge, Ind, Jamui in connection with Sessions Trial Nb. 174 of 2016 arising out of Sikandra PS Case Nb. 181 of 2015.
