counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted under
Sections 30(a), 38, 47 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged that 115 litres of foreign liquor is said to
have been recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is in custody since 16.08.2017. The petitioner has got
no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that 115 litres

On behalf of the state, it has been submitted that the
