- 2 20-11-2017 The petitioners seek regular bail in connection with
- Revilganj P.S. Case No. 218 of 2017, registered for offences
- punishable under Section 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and
- Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of 80 litres of country made liquor from petitioner no. 1 and allegation is of recovery of 70 litres of country made liquor from petitioner no. 2.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that in this case there is no compliance of Section 100 of Cr.P.C. Further petitioner has no criminal antecedents and they have been in judicial custody since 28.09.2017.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of allegation, period of custody and also that petitioners have no criminal antecedent, let the petitioners above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 6th Additional Sessions Judge, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Revilganj P.S. Case No. 218 of 2017, subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) It is made clear that if the petitioners again found involved in any of the like offences, in future, prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of their bail bonds.
