I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
offences punishable under sections 272 and 273 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 30 (a), 32 (b), 38(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 162 litres 750 ML.
of foreign liquor were recovered from the vehicle. The
petitioner is the driver of the said vehicle. It is urged that the
petitioner is in custody since 26.3.2017. It is claimed that his
antecedent is clean.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the
case, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on



bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Addl. Sessions Judge II – cum – Special Judge, Excise, Lakhisarai, in Barahiya P.S. Case No. 58 of 2017.

If the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
