Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel  
appearing on behalf of O.P. No.2 and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with  
Compliant Case No.332 of 2011, registered under Section 498(A) of  
the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The accusation is of torturing and causing assault of the  
complainant/O.P. No.2 by her husband and other in-laws due to non-  
fulfillment of demand of dowry and removing her from the  
matrimonial house.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the  
joint prayer of the parties, the matter was referred to the Mediation  
Centre, Patna High Court, Patna for settlement of dispute between the



petitioner and O.P. No.2, who are husband and wife, where petitioner expressed his desire to keep his wife O.P. No.2, but she was not ready to live with the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing on behalf of O.P. No.2 submits that due to torture and harassment at the hand of the petitioner, O.P. No.2 feels unsafe to go to her matrimonial house and she wants one time settlement.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M. Saasaram in connection with Compliant Case No. 332 of 2011, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
