5 04-09-2017 Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present application with liberty to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority against the order dated 6.6.2012 passed in Case No.798 of 2011 by the District Teachers Employment Appellate Authority, East Champaran at Motihari.
