3. 20-07-2017 Heard Smt. Anita Kumari Singh, learned counsel for
the petitioner and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, who is mother-in-law of the
deceased and named in the F.I.R. with specific accusation of
putting informant on fire, who subsequently died, has prayed for
grant of anticipatory bail.

Considering the specific accusation and the *fardbeyan*
of the deceased, there is no reason to extend the privilege of
anticipatory bail.
