The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Vaishali P.S. Case No.255 of 2016 for allegedly having committed the offence under Sections 354A, 354C, 354D of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 67 and 67A of the Information Technology Act, 2000, pending in the court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali.
