The learned Writ Court has decided the writ petition in terms of order dated 21.09.2015 passed in C.W.J.C. No.5638 of 2011 and various other analogous cases decided by a common order and in the common order passed an Enquiry Commission was directed to look into the grievance of the P.D.S. dealer.

Taking note of the facts, the petitioner himself has been granted opportunity to appear before the appropriate Committee and



ventilate his grievance as indicated in the case of C.W.J.C. No.5638 of 2011 and various other analogous cases, we see no reason to make any indulgence into the matter.

The appeal stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to appear before the Committee and raise all ground before the committee.
