ORAL ORDER

2. 12-04-2017 The present writ petition has been listed under the heading “To Be Mentioned” on the basis of mentioning slip filed on behalf of the petitioner. By way of filing mentioning slip, a prayer was made for disposal of the writ petition with an observation to take decision on the representation of the petitioner i.e. Annexure – 6 to the writ petition. It has categorically been submitted that petitioner does not want any direction on the merit of the case, but an observation for disposal of his representation.

In view of limited prayer made by learned counsel for



the petitioner, in presence of learned A.C. to Govt. Pleader – 9 as well as Sri Nikesh Kumar, learned counsel for the respondent/South Bihar Power Distribution Co. Ltd., the Court proposes for disposal of the writ petition.
