In the matter of appointment of Panchayat Shiksha Mitra, the learned Writ Court has found that now after abolition of the post of Shiksha Mitra, the petition has been rendered infructuous and the question need not be considered. The aforesaid finding recorded by the learned Writ Court is in view of a judgment rendered by a



Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kalpana Rani Vs. State of Bihar, 2014(2) PLJR 665**, and we see no reason to make any indulgence into the matter. The appeal stands dismissed.
