2 20-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 457, 380 and
411/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR of the occurrence of theft is against
unknown. From the ancestral house of the petitioner nephew of the
petitioner was, allegedly, apprehended along with some stolen
property.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Petitioner never
resides at the ancestral house and his name has surfaced on the
basis of confessional statement of nephew.



Considering the aforesaid material, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur/successor Court in connection with Bela Police Station Case No. 24 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
