ORAL ORDER

4 31-01-2017 The petitioner is in custody since 3.8.2016 in connection with Ara Town P.S. Case No. 371 of 2016, registered for offences punishable under Section 25(1-B)a/26/5 of the Arms Act.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that except confessional statement of co-accused there is nothing against the petitioner, even there is no recovery and the petitioner is in custody since 30.8.2016.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard the learned counsel for both sides and considering the submissions, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty



five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ara, Bhojpur in connection with Ara Town P.S.Case No. 371 of 2016, with following conditions:-

(i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.

(ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.

(iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move the cancellation of his bail.
