Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Bathnaha Police Station Case No. 108 of 2016, disclosing
offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 353, 504, 283
and 337 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the D.P.
Act.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that there is general and omnibus allegation against this
petitioner and no specific overt act is attributed to him. In fact,
the petitioner happens to be the co-villager of the deceased, who
is said to be died in an accident, and he has no concern with the
alleged occurrence. Not a single person has sustained injury. No



any witnesses have supported the prosecution version. Hence, the petitioner deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi, in connection with Bathnaha Police Station Case No. 108 of 2016, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
