Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in Sakra P.S.

Case No. 383 of 2013 instituted for the offence under Sections
304(B), 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted that petitioner is mother-in-law
of the deceased. It has further been submitted that husband and
father-in-law of the deceased are in custody.

From the written report it appears that there is general
and omnibus allegation against the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,
prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed. In the
event of surrender/arrest of the petitioner, named above, within six
weeks from today, in connection with Sakra P.S. Case No. 383 of



2013, she shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Smt. Rashmi, learned A.C.J.M-IV, Muzaffarpur, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioner and (3) if petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
