ORAL ORDER

8 18-07-2017 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of C.R. No.184 of 2015, disclosing offences under Sections
341, 323, 384, 380, 498(A), 504 and 409/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel for the parties has submitted that
the parties have settled their dispute by process of mediation
vide Mediation Proceeding No. 73 of 2017 before the Patna
High Court Mediation & Reconciliation Centre, Patna, which is
evident from mediation report at flag-B. Hence, the petitioner
deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub- Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Biraul in connection with C.R. No.184 of 2015, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
