This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Trial No. 3255 of 2016, disclosing offences under
Sections 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the
Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that
the petitioner happens to be the husband of the complainant is
innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, the
petitioner admits his marriage with the complainant and he is
ready to keep the complainant as wife with full honour and



dignity. Statement to that effect has been made in paragraph-6 of the petition. Hence, the petitioner deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner and submitted that there is allegation of torture and demand of dowry against the petitioner, who is husband of the complainant. Moreover, the reconciliation has not been succeeded between them

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail of this petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner is, hereby, rejected.
