The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Nawada Town P.S. Case No.441 of 2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 20/22 of the N.D.P.S. Act, pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge (N.D.P.S.), Nawada.

100 gms. of ganja was allegedly recovered from the possession of the petitioner.
