2 30-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the counsel appearing on behalf of the State as well as the University.

Petitioner is aggrieved by the order contained in (Annexure-8). Annexure-8 is simply a request by the Registrar to produce certain documents so that further action may be taken.

In view of the kind of request made by the Registrar, Kameshwar Singh Darbhanga Sanskrit University, Kameshwar Nagar, Darbhanga, contained in Annexure-8, the present writ is premature. The petitioner, if so advised, may submit necessary



documents or reason for non- providing those documents before the Registrar instead of pressing this writ petition.
