I.A. No. 9550 of 2015 is allowed. Delay of 56 days is
condoned for the reasons indicated in the Interlocutory Application.
Matter is taken up on merits as well.

The learned single Judge has disposed of the writ
application with an observation that the petitioners' grievance stood
redressed.



Today counsel for the appellants submits that there are certain villagers who had refused to remove the encroachment and they are still settled on a public *rasta*, which is a public land.

If the cause subsists, the law still can be invoked against such persons.

Appeal is otherwise dismissed since there is no infirmity with the order of the learned single Judge.
